

Two Implants Post-Extraction with Autogenous Bone Graft & Tunnel Connective Tissue Graft

Case Notes

Patient presented for extraction of #7 and #9, with a depression on the ridge width on area of # 8. Ritter implants were placed post-extraction with an autogenous bone graft placed inside the socket with the implants in placed. A CTG was placed on the pontic area of #8. A provisional restoration was placed 10 weeks post-op. we are now working on the soft tissue guided healing for the papillae, and should restore definitely in the near future.
